French Immersion Program (FI)

For families interested in French Immersion, parents can apply for their child to join the program starting in grade one. This immersive experience spans from grades 1 to 8, where students devote 50% of their daily instruction to learning in French and the remaining 50% in English. The goal is for students to achieve proficiency in French while continually honing their English language skills.

Extended French

Beginning in grade 7, the Extended French program offers intensified French, serving as an alternative to French Immersion. Students spend half their day studying language arts, social studies, and science in French. In high school, they earn four Extended French credits and three in other French-taught subjects, receiving a Certificate of Extended French Studies at graduation.

Trustee Engagements Across School Communities

As a school board trustee, visiting schools is a source of immense joy. Each visit offers an invaluable glimpse into the PDSB educational landscape. These visits are driven by my commitment to children and families, aiming to understand their diverse needs. PDSB November 29, 2023 Board Meeting

The November Board meeting saw the administration presenting the Annual Equity <u>Accountability Report Card, Fall 2023</u>. This report provides a thorough examination of how the PDSB is addressing the diverse needs of the school community. The key themes include the persistent disparities faced by Indigenous, African, Black, and Afro-Caribbean students, the necessity for increased resources for students with special education needs and higher socioeconomic vulnerabilities, and the ongoing imperative to create positive learning environments for Two-Spirit LGBTQIA+ students facing systemic barriers. This report underscores the ongoing work which aims to foster an inclusive and supportive educational environment within the PDSB community.
